

NB Driver's Handbook "By the Numbers"

- A Class 7 requires a minimum 24 months experience before receiving full licence.
- Class 7 must maintain 0 % Blood Alcohol, or will receive 1 year suspension.
- A loss of all points while you hold a class 7 = 3 month suspension.
- Class 7 Level 1 to Level 2 = 8 months with a driving school or 12 months without.
- Class 6D = Motorcycles < 550cc Class 6 = Motorcycles > 550cc
- Motorcycle Graduated Licence = 12 Months in duration
- Every driver, other than a newly licensed driver, is issued 10 points.
- A driver that has been driving for less than 4 years is considered a newly licensed driver.
- Newly Licensed Drivers, are issued 4 points.
- A newly licensed drivers will be issued 2 additional points per year, to a max of 10 points.
- A loss of 10 points within 2 years = Automatic Suspension
- As of 1990, all vehicle must be equipped with daytime running lights.
- Lights should render clearly discernible persons and vehicles on the highway at a distance of at least 150 meters.
- Excl. Motorcycle, all vehicle must have 2 headlights.
- Lights must have an high beam visible to 100 meters and low beam visible to 30m.
- Lights must be dimmed within 150 meters of an approaching vehicle.
- When following another vehicle within 60 meters the lower beam must be used.
- Motorcycle Lights shall be strong enough to reveal a person or vehicle at 100 meters when speed is 60 km/h or more.
- All cars/trucks must have at least two red "Tail Lights" that are visible from a distance of 150 meters to the rear and white licence plate light visible from 15m.
- Vehicles must be have a red stop light visible from a distance of 100 meters to the rear.
- Turn signals must be visible from a distance of 30 meters both to the front and rear.
- All Vehicle must have a horn that can be heard for a distance of not less than 60 meters.
- Every motor vehicle must be equipped with a mirror to reflect a view of the highway of at least 60 meters to the rear.
- A vehicle must not exceed 260cm wide and 415cm high.
- Studded winter tires are permitted between October 15th and April 30th.

Rules of the Road

- Collision damage >\$1000 must be reported to the RCMP and insurance must be provided.
- If a vehicle is disabled, the operator shall place a portable reflector unit at a distance of 30 meters to the rear of the vehicle.
- With no speed hazards or posted speed limits, the speed limits = 50 km/h (city), 80 km/h (outside the city).
- You must bring your vehicle to a full stop > than 5 meters in front or rear of a school bus.
- The speed limit for school zones is 50 km/h in the city unless a different speed is posted.
- Speed limit for school zones is in effect from 7:30 a.m. 4:00 p.m. on school days.
- The speed limit in construction Zones is 50 km/h in the city unless a different rate of speed has been posted.
- All signals shall be given at least 30 meters before making a turn.

Rules of the Road

- It is illegal to drive on the left side of the road within 30m of an intersection or bridge.
- It illegal to pass a vehicle on the left within 150m where your forward view is obstructed.
- At railway crossings, you must bring your vehicle to a stop not less than 5 meters from the nearest rail and shall not proceed until it is safe.
- Vehicles cannot be parked on a highway unless there are 5 meters of unobstructed roadway remaining for other traffic.
- The parked vehicle must be clearly seen for a distance of 60 meters.
- It is an offence to follow an emergency vehicle within 150 meters.
- Parking not permitted: < 5m from fire hydrant
 - < 5m from crosswalk
 - < 10m from stop sign
 - < 10m opposite a fire station
 - < 15m from railway crossings
 - > 50cm from a curb.

Safe Driving

- Under normal conditions, the average reaction time is about three quarters (3/4) of a second.
- In 3/4 of a second your car travelling at 50 km/h will go 10 meters.
- All motorists under the age of 21 must maintain a 0% Blood Alcohol Level.
- Drivers who are found to have a blood alcohol concentration between 0.05% and 0.08% are subject to a suspension.
- Being apprehended at above 0.08% blood alcohol in the bloodstream, is a criminal offence.

Motorcycle

- Motorcycle handlebars shall not be more than 30cm in height as measured vertically from its point of attachment at the frame.
- Motorcycle mirrors must give the rider a view of at least 60m to the rear.
- Motorcycle horns must be capable of being heard at 60m.
- Motorcycle front brakes provides 70% of total braking force.
- When making a sharp turn on your motorcycle < 25 km/h, you should lean the motorcycle in the direction of the turn farther than your body.
- Motorcycle riders must keep at least a 2 second following distance from the vehicle in front.

- It is illegal for a commercial motor vehicle to follow another vehicle within 60 meters except for the purpose of overtaking and passing.
- It is an offence to follow within 150 meters of any fire apparatus.
- It is also an offence to drive or park within 150 meters of any fire apparatus which has stopped in answer to an alarm.
- Truckers can have blind spots of up to 60 meters to the rear of the trailer.
- Truckers can have blind spots of up to 3 meters to the front because of the trucks tall profile.
